A large (12m) whale was buried on the beach here on 24 January 2024. Dead rotting whales can carry diseases that contaminate your skin and clothing, so please stay at least 5m away and avoid walking in any sand or water that may be contaminated.

Shellfish gathering and swimming are NOT RECOMMENDED near here before 1 May 2024.





It is an offence under the Marine Mammals take whalebone without a permit.
